Travel 1.2 miles & take EXIT 4, MEADOWRIDGE ROAD (MD-103) & merge right at top of exit. Travel .2 mile & turn right onto MONTGOMERY ROAD—Travel .1 mile & go straight onto MARSHALEE DRIVE—Travel .9 mile, Timbers lot on right

From US-29 - Take Exit 22, MD-100 EAST toward Glen Burnie
